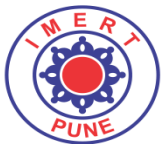

A post survey visit under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan (UBA) initiative of Ministry of Education, Government of India, was recently conducted by MM's IMERT on 19th May,2023 under the guidance of Dr Shubhangee Ramaswamy, I/C Director, IMERT. The visit was co-ordinated by Prof Pranjal Jadhav, UBA Co-ordinator and Prof Chaitrali Kale, UBA Member. The visit was done at the two villages in Mawal district (Tikona and Thakursai) along with two student representatives Pranita Lodha and Shrikar Supekar.

The visit enabled to identify the issues faced by the villagers and the probable solutions and requirements to resolve those issues and to create awareness among the villagers pertaining to the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan initiative.
