

Faculty Development Program on ERP Training by Vmedulife

Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Institute of Management Education Research and Training (MM's IMERT) organized 5 days Faculty Development Program (FDP) on ERP training from 10th June 2023 to 15th June 2023. This FDP was initiated and supported by Incharge Director of MM's IMERT Dr. Shubhangee Ramaswamy.

During the FDP trainers from Vmedulife Mr. Rishikesh Chhachwale, Mr. Abhijit Yeole and Mr. Omkar Satpute provided information about ERP software and it's usage through modules. Various modules covered during the FDP were Academic Planning, CO-PO Attainment, Online Feedback and Surveys, Online Examinations, Mentoring, Event Management, Course File, Leave Management etc.

Day one started with the introduction of user interface and different modules of ERP. Mr. Rishikesh explained how the user interface (UI) of an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system is crucial as it directly impacts user productivity, efficiency and overall satisfaction.

On day two Mr. Abhijit Yeole covered how an Academic Planning module facilitates managing and streamlining various aspects of academic planning within educational institutions. He also gave training on Course File module which is designed to manage comprehensive details and documentation related to courses offered by the institution.

Day three focused on Online Feedback and Surveys and Online examinations.

On day four Mr. Omkar Satpute started with Mentoring module followed by how to upload events

and activities in Event Management Module.

Day five focused on CO-PO Attainment wherein Mr. Rishikesh emphasized on how the CO-PO (Course Outcomes - Program Outcomes) Attainment module plays a crucial role in assessing and ensuring that the learning outcomes defined for courses are aligned with the broader program goals.

Total 11 faculty members attended the FDP and got hands-on training of different modules of ERP.






MS Office Certification – IIT Kanpur (29 May – 31 May 2023)


The session was very helpful for students because PMA members gave their important suggestions which were very helpful for students to grow and develop themselves for giving best interviews for placements.

UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN - UBA (12, 29 July 2022)



Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is inspired the vision of by transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India. The Mission of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate

solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. The conceptualization of Unnat Bhārat Abhiyān started with the initiative of a group of dedicated faculty members of IIT Delhi working for long in the area of rural development and appropriate technology. The concept was nurtured through wide consultation with the representatives of a number of technical institutions, RuTAG coordinators. voluntary organizations and Govt. agencies actively involved in rural



development work, during a National workshop held at IIT Delhi in September, 2014. The program was formally launched by MHRD in October, 2014.

MM's IMERT is one of the participating institutions (PIs) is expected to establish a UBA Cell which will be responsible for carrying out the activities of the UBA. This will involve the development of an active working group consisting of motivated faculty members drawn from various disciplines. The main responsibility of a UBA cell will be primarily to develop linkage with selective rural clusters, involve in the planning process and to promote the requisite S&T interventions to improvise and expedite the developmental efforts in those clusters.

MM's IMERT has adopted five villages under UBA project. Following are the adopted villages - Dingrajwadi, Thakursai, Tikona, Wajewadi, Kasari.





IMERT has received seed money of Rs. Fifty thousand from Ministry of Education(Govt of India) for conducting the village and household survey in the above mentioned five villages under UBA. MM's IMERT has completed the first phase of the survey for all the five villages in the month of April 2022.

The second phase of the project was to conduct the household survey. This was conducted in two



visits. First visit was conducted on 12th July 2022, in which 110 students and 11 faculty members participated to conduct the household survey in three adopted villages viz-Kasari. Dingarajwadi and Wajewadi in Shirur district , Pune,. The second visit was conducted on 29th July 2022 which covered two adopted villages viz. Thakur Sai and Tikona in Maval

district, Pune. During both the visits students interacted with the villagers and the local administration, and



tried to understand the social life, Functioning of Administration from Grass root level and aspects of Human Development in these areas. The main objective of this programme is to provide students with insights into





the rural economy and the challenges faced by the people. After this programme students able to understand the problems and challenges of local authorities and village people. Students conducted a detail survey, in which they took the information required in the household survey forms given by UBA.





Commodity Derivatives Awareness Program in association with Security Exchange Board of India (SEBI) at Baramati

An awareness program on commodity derivatives was organized for the farmers of Baramati Taluka in Pune District on 11 October 2022, at Anand High School ,Hol,Baramati, Maharastra.

This program was designed and organized by Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Institute of Management Education Research and Training (IMERT) and Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) with the help of Mr. Sidharth Gite, Executive Vice President, Someshwar Sugar Factory, Baramati, and his team members.

The two-hour program was directed towards educating farmers about the importance, features, and process of commodity derivatives. The session was mostly in Marathi language. About 40 farmers attended the session.

Mr. Shrikant Kuwalekar, Senior Journalist of Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) was the resource person of the session.

Mr. Shrikant Kuwalekar ensured the session was interactive since the beginning. He combined the traditional chalk-board teaching technique and modern Power Point presentation method to ensure that the farmers understand the concept.

The session started with discussion with the farmers regarding Agricultural Produce Market Committee (APMC) and the global and national market scenario. Mr. Shrikant Kuwalekar, in layman terms, explained spot market, call & put option, role and history of National Commodity & Derivatives Exchange Limited (NCDEX).







Further in the session, he introduced farmers with functions of NeML (krishi vedh) and concept of eauction. He used examples of commodities such as ajwain, soyabean and so on to expand on the concept. He also briefly touched the topic of gold and explained the role of Multi Commodity Exchange of India Limited (MCX).

By the end of the session, Mr. Shrikant Kuwalekar presented the system on basis of which commodity market works through diagrams. He explained farmers the ways they can involve themselves as a producer as well as a trader. He briefly explained the process through which the farmers can get involved and start their journey in commodity markets.

The session ended with a Q&A round where Mr. Shrikant Kuwalekar answered several interesting and constructive questions from the audience.

The concluding remarks were given my Dr. Mangalgouri Patil. She briefed the audience about Marathwada Mitra Mandal's IMERT and the awareness program. She talked about SEBI's objective behind conducting such initiative. Dr. Patil explained the importance of investment in different avenues such as gold and commodity market. She encouraged the farmers to start with small but consistent steps towards learning and understanding commodity market and other investment avenues. She ended her remarks by assuring that more informative sessions like these will be conducted by Marathwada Mitra Mandal's IMERT.

The vote of thanks was given by Ms. Chaitrali Kale. She emphasized on the need of such awareness program for farmers. She concluded her vote of thanks by expressing her gratefulness towards all the organizers, speaker, school staff, participants and volunteers.

Ms Gauri Patil and Mr. Rutuved Joshi (Student,IMERT) along with Dr. Mangalgouri S Patil(Assistant Professor) and Ms. Chaitrali Kale coordinated for the program.

.NELDA (Visit to Hanuman Tekdi 11 Jun 2023)



Nelda is an Irish word that means 'champion'. People working for the environment are champions. Nelda's vision is to help people plant and grow a billion trees in India by 2041. On 26th June, 2016, first ever event of Project Nelda, planted over 200 trees with the help of 25+ volunteers at Hanuman Tekdi, Pune.

Nelda's first collaboration was with the IMERT, Pune, where the students volunteered for carrying out Nelda activities. On 11th June 2023 a group of 6 students with one faculty member visited Hanumaan Tekdi for the conservation of plants by watering them through tanks on the hill. Pune corporation pumps water in tanks built on Tekdi, volunteers during summer season need to take care of new planted small sapling because of extreme heat. Water is provided through buckets from the tanks by volunteers, human chain is formed to reach every corner of the hill and take care of every plant. Students through this activity come close to the environment and realize the importance of trees and efforts needed to grow the trees. Working together in team, planning, coordination and resource management are take away learning for the students.

Founder Director Mr. Vedarth Deshpande addressed the students and shared the mission of Nelda. Nelda believes that if more and more youngsters are involved in social work, then not only can the work be done more efficiently, but eventually it will also result into sustainable growth. Hence, at Nelda, focus is to try to inspire the young generation to work for the environment, Nelda generally plants trees like Karanj, Kanchan, Neem, Tamrind, Banyan and few others which are native to the Deccan Platter i.e. the geography of Pune. This will help regain the ecological

balance. These native trees help to fight climate change and help in conserving wild habitat and water as they adjust to the local environment..
