Academic and Administrative Audit Report – Year 2018-19 Observations, Comments and Suggestions

Teaching Learning and Evaluation

- a) Faculties have prepared and maintained teaching plan and course files.
- b) Academic calendar and time table are available and followed.
- c) SPPU norms are followed for conducting concurrent evaluation.
- d) Use of ICT Tools for teaching learning is good.
- e) ET Cases were incorporated in Teaching learning.

Student Support and Progression

- a) Various certifications/value added programs/workshops like MS-Excel Basics, Business English communication, Financial Cyber Security and Entrepreneurship Development were organized by the institute.
- b) Placement training activities were conducted for the students.
- c) Student participated in inter and intra college cocurricular and extracurricular activities.
- d) Students' faculty interaction is well maintained in the form of mentoring to support student holistic development.
- e) Specialization related inputs were given to students to enhance their specific domain skills in internship.
- f) Industry Experts were invited for SIP evaluation.
